

## TIPS ON MAKING YOUR SCARECROW

There are some great videos on Youtube and TikTok, showing simple steps on what you'll need and where to start. If you don't fancy using straw, you could use scrunched up paper or filled bags in the clothing to build your body shape - the old fashioned broom stick and an old shirt would even work!

When making your scarecrow, please make sure there is a wooden pole / plank coming out of the top / secured on the back to help us display it in the paddock.
